

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-02

AN ORDINANCE abating the tax heretofore levied for the year 2025 to pay debt service on \$13,000,000 General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2024, of the Aurora Public Library District, Kane, DuPage, Kendall and Will Counties, Illinois.

WHEREAS, The Board of Library Trustees (the "Board") of the Aurora Public Library District, Kane, DuPage, Kendall and Will Counties, Illinois (the "District"), by ordinance adopted on the 25th day of September, 2024 (the "Bond Ordinance"), did provide for the issue of \$13,000,000 General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2024 (the "Bonds"), and the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay principal and interest on the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the District will have Pledged Revenues (as defined in the Bond Ordinance) available for the purpose of paying the debt service due on the Bonds during the next succeeding bond year; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the District that the tax heretofore levied for the year 2025 to pay such debt service on the Bonds be abated:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It is Hereby Ordained by The Board of Library Trustees of the Aurora Public Library District, Kane, DuPage, Kendall and Will Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Abatement of Tax. The tax heretofore levied for the year 2025 in the Bond Ordinance is hereby abated as follows:

Section 2. Filing of Ordinance. Forthwith upon the adoption of this Ordinance, the Secretary of the Board shall file a certified copy hereof with the County Clerks of Kane, DuPage, Kendall and Will Counties, Illinois, and it shall be the duty of said County Clerks to abate said tax levied for the year 2025 in accordance with the provisions hereof.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.

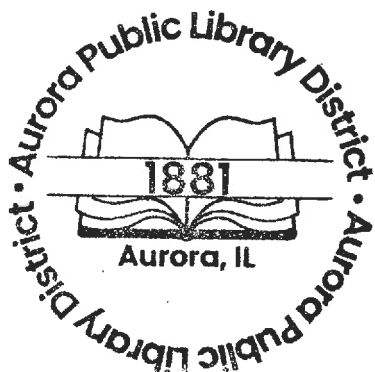

After a full and complete discussion thereof, Board President Joe Filapek presented and read by title an ordinance as follows, a copy of which was provided to each Library Trustee of The Board of Library Trustees prior to said meeting and to everyone in attendance at said meeting who requested a copy.

Library Trustee Riddick moved and Library Trustee Draighean seconded the motion that said ordinance as presented and read by title be adopted.

After a full discussion thereof, the President directed that the roll be called for a vote upon the motion to adopt said ordinance.

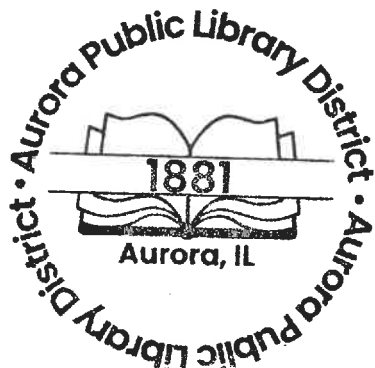
