## Make sure to bring the following documents with you to the tax site

- Original photo identification for you and your spouse (if married filing jointly), such as a: Valid U.S driver's license; Employer ID; School ID; State ID (U.S.); Military ID; National ID; Visa; Passport
- Social Security cards for you, your spouse and dependents
- An Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) notice [CP-01A, We assigned you an identity protection personal identification number \(IP PIN\)](#) for you, your spouse and your dependents if you do not have a Social Security number (SSN)
- Proof of foreign status, if applying for an ITIN
- Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents on the tax return
- Wage and earning statements (Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, 1099-MISC) from all employers
- [Social Security Benefit Statements \(SSA-1099\)](#), if applicable
- Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099)
- A copy of last year's federal and state returns, if available
- Proof of bank account routing and account numbers for direct deposit, such as a blank check
- Total paid for daycare provider and the daycare provider's tax identifying number, such as their SSN or business EIN
- Health Insurance Exemption Certificate, if received
- Forms 1095-A, Health Insurance Marketplace Statement
- Copies of income transcripts from IRS and state, if applicable
- To file taxes electronically on a married-filing-joint tax return, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms

However, if you need help from an IRS Taxpayer Assistance Center (TAC) you need to call to schedule an appointment. Go to IRS.gov/taclocator to find the location and telephone number of your local TAC.
