Key Responsibilities:

- Plan, promote and provide programs for all ages from young children to older adults at community locations and on library vehicles.
- Provide reference and readers advisory services at multiple service points, including on the bookmobile and at off-site facilities
- Instruct customers on research skills and the use of library resources
- Drive the library outreach van to facilities and events; transfer book carts and program supplies from the library building onto the library van and into the facilities we serve
- Research and create attractive outreach displays
- Participate in committees, partnerships and outreach initiatives
- Assist with collection maintenance and weeding

Minimum Qualifications:

- ALA accredited MLS/MLIS
- Two years public library experience or relevant experience
- Spanish language skills, both verbal and written, strongly preferred
- Valid driver's license
- Ability to occasionally lift up to 50 pounds, and push 100 pounds on a wheeled book cart
- Excellent communication and customer service skills
- Experience with programming and/or event planning
- Ability to work both collaboratively and individually
- Ability to work evenings and weekends, adjusting as required for programming
