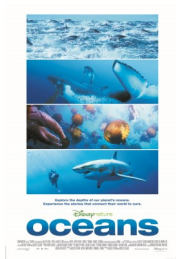


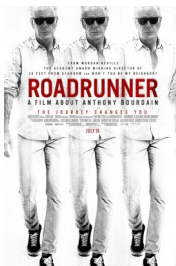
Monday Movie Marathons

Apr. 8 - Oceans (1h 24m)

Apr. 15 - Roadrunner: A Film About Anthony Bourdain (1h 35m)
