



Library Card Design Contest

Amateur artists of all ages are invited to share what the Bettendorf Library means to them. Winning design submissions will be featured on limited edition library cards!

RULES

- Create a drawing or design using the supplied template. Submissions should celebrate some aspect of the library, literacy, or otherwise reflect what the library means to you.
- Artwork can include computer-generated (excluding AI generated), digital photographic images, or paper submission using colored pencil, paint, markers, etcetera.
- Submissions must be the creative and original work of a single individual, previously unpublished, and free of third-party copyright restrictions.
- Upon submission, entrants assign to the Bettendorf Public Library Information Center the entire right, title, and interest in and to all copyrights in the artwork and consent that all artwork may be displayed and/or reproduced without limitation or compensation.
- Participation is limited to current Bettendorf Public Library cardholders, or their minor children.
- Entries must be submitted in person at the Bettendorf Public Library or through our email at info@bettendorflibrary.com between April 1 - April 30, 2024.
- Artwork must include the Bettendorf Public Library logo.
- Entries must be accompanied by a completed and signed release form.
- Do not include your name in the artwork.
- Limit one entry per person.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Representatives from the Bettendorf Public Library will select top designs in each of four categories as finalists: YOUTH (9 and under), TEEN/TWEEN (10-17), ADULT (18 and over), and current Bettendorf Library Staff members.
- Finalists will be selected at the library's discretion. If the submissions received in the category are not deemed suitable, the library may choose to not select a finalist.
- The public will be able to vote from among the finalists to select a favorite in each category to turn into a library card.
- Library cards with the winning designs will be released during Library Card Sign-up Month, September 2024.
