





Bexley Public Library: Reflecting Our Community's Commitment to Lifelong Learning

Ruth Laudahn, BPL's first trained children's librarian, was hired, enabling the library to offer regular storytimes and support early childhood education.

> BPL expanded its library card access to include all Franklin County residents.

Mary Teeter Zimmerman, BPL's Library Director, began presenting "Fun With Books," a WBNS radio show geared to children. It became

> BPL was one of the first libraries in central Ohio to serve the homebound with book delivery service.

The first computers were available for public use, giving patrons access

BPL's popular live-music series, Tea at Three, began, and the tradition continues today with the help of the Samuel C. and Gale M. Shamansky Fund at the Library.

BPL began live streaming programs, distributing free COVID-19 test kits, and expanded its home delivery service in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic.




