Go Paperless and File Electronically!

Most Ohio income tax returns are filed electronically. Therefore, this facility no longer carries the Ohio individual and school district income tax instructions or any Ohio tax forms.



OH|TAX eServices is Ohio's new online system for Ohio taxpayers and tax preparers. This system offers an online "banking experience" to simplify and enhance our online services while safeguarding taxpayer information. Scan the QR code at the top right or visit

Highlights for Tax Year 2023

- **Filing Deadline** – The due date for tax year 2023 is April 15, 2024. While Ohio automatically honors the IRS extension, remember that an extension to file **is not** an extension to pay any tax due.
- **529 Plan Deduction** – This deduction is now available for all states' 529 plans, not just Ohio!
- **Ohio Adoption Grant Deduction** – This new adoption grant (administered by the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services) can be deducted on the Ohio Schedule of Adjustments.
- **Redesigned SD 100** – The school district income tax return has been redesigned for 2023! Taxpayers who need to file for more than one school district will now only need to file a single return.
- **New Payment Coupon** – The new Ohio Universal Payment Coupon (OUPC) should be used for all individual and school district income tax payments made by check or money order.

Other Reminders

- **Pay Electronically!** – Whether you file your returns electronically or by paper, you may be eligible to pay by electronic check or credit/debit card via ODT's OH|TAX eServices (registration required) or Guest Payment Service (no registration required). Electronic check payments are **free** while there is a convenience fee for debit and credit card payments. Visit tax.ohio.gov/pay for more information.
- **School District Income Tax** – You may be subject to school district income tax if you live in a taxing school district. If you do not know the school district in which you live or if it has an income tax, use "The Finder" at tax.ohio.gov/Finder to search by your address.
- **Taxpayer Assistance** – Call 1-800-282-1780* (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday - Friday excluding holidays) to get assistance with your Ohio individual and school district income tax questions.
