Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Cape May County Library Commission held on Wednesday, February 18, 2026 at 1:30pm, in the Board Room of the Cape May County Library in Cape May Court House, NJ.

1. Mrs. Henderson called the meeting to order and announced it was being held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act.
2. The minutes of the regular meeting of January 21 2026 were presented for review and approval. Mr. Mastrangelo made a motion to approve the minutes, which Mrs. Henderson seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Orsini presented the bills for the month of February for review and approval for payment. The list of bills was discussed. Mrs. Henderson made a motion to approve the bills for payment, which Mrs. Thomas seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
4. Under old business:
 - a. Orsini reported that the new bookmobile was still being processed, so expected use is pushed back to March.
 - b. Orsini also reported on the Court House Library HVAC project.
 - c. Orsini reported that the new panels for the Cape May City Library will be installed soon, and building issues under warranty are being noted.
5. Under new business:
 - a. Orsini reported on the January 2026 programming statistics and noted there were 4,643 participants in the month of January including programs and Outreach.
 - b. Orsini presented the Strategic Outlook Progress report and noted where identifiable progress has been made towards the library's four strategic priorities.
 - c. Resolution February 2026 #1, Separations, was introduced. Mrs. Henderson made a motion to accept the resolution, which Mrs. Thomas seconded. The resolution passed unanimously.
 - d. Resolution February 2026 #2, LOAs, was introduced. Mrs. Henderson made a motion to accept the resolution, which Mrs. Thomas seconded. The resolution passed unanimously.
 - e. Resolution February 2026 #3, Advancements, was introduced. Mrs. Henderson made a motion to accept the resolution, which Mrs. Thomas seconded. The resolution passed unanimously.
6. It was noted that the statistics for the month of January 2026 were listed on the agenda.
7. There being no further business, the Commission adjourned.
