



## How to Log Your Progress

This year, we've integrated Bookworm activities and reading minutes into a BINGO card, so you can track everything in one place! You can use the BINGO card in this book to mark your progress, **but be sure to log it online too.**

## Create an account, or sign in

- Visit [CRCPL.org/bookworm](https://www.crcpl.org/bookworm). Select the "Bookworm Summer Reading" program.
- If you participated in Bookworm last year, or our Winter Reading program in January, you can sign in using your username and password from before. If not, you can sign up for a new account.
- You can create either an individual or family account. A family account lets you log things for your whole family without having to log into individual accounts.
- For each reader, you'll pick one Bookworm Challenge:
  - Read to Me: a 3x3 BINGO card (birth-starting Kindergarten)
  - Independent Readers: a 4x4 BINGO card for kids who read on their own, though being read to counts too! (grades K-6)
  - Teens: a 5x5 BINGO card (grades 7-12)
  - Adults: a 5x5 BINGO card (18+)
- We need a contact phone number on your account in order to receive the grand prize.
- You can also download and sign in using the Beanstack app. You'll need to search for Chillicothe and Ross County Public Library and sign in using your username and password.

## Logging

- You will be able to log your reading and activities starting June 5, 2023, and all logging must be complete by noon on July 26, 2023.
- Sign into your Beanstack account, and click the red button that says "Log Reading and Activities." (Note: you will not see this button until June 5, when Bookworm officially starts.)
- Choose whether you want to log minutes or activities, or start a reading timer. If you use the reading timer in Beanstack, those reading minutes are logged automatically. As you add reading minutes, Beanstack will fill in the reading minutes BINGO squares for you, in the order you see to the left.

## Prizes

### Kids:

- Free book after you log your first BINGO
- Fill the whole card, and get another free book, a trophy (at or after our Bookworm Finale Party), a coupon booklet, and an entry into our grand prize drawing.

### Adults:

- Entry into one of 8 drawings for a reading prize pack after you log your first BINGO
- Fill the whole card, and receive a coupon booklet and an entry into our grand prize drawing.
