I can ask the person for a tour of the library.

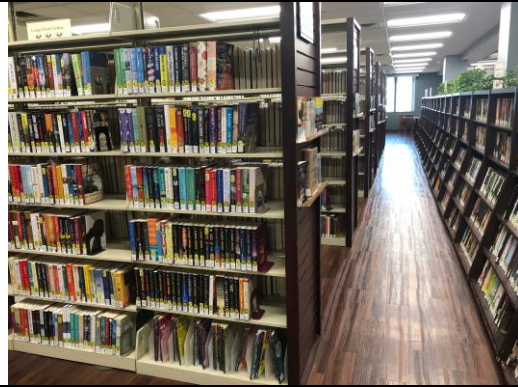


## About the library

There are Information Desks on the First Floor, the Lower Level, and the Second Floor. The library staff there can help me.



The library is usually a quiet place where people talk quietly, relax, and read books.



Sometimes it might be noisy. If it is too noisy a staff person will help me find a quieter area.



## How to get a library card

When I get to the library I will see a big desk. This is called the Circulation Desk.



I will talk to someone who works there to get a library card.

Library staff should be wearing a badge that look something like this.



I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number, and email address.



I will show them identification. I will show them a photo ID that has my name and current address (such as a driver's license).



I will sign a form. This makes me a member of the library and I will be given a library card.



## When I visit the library

In the library there will be shelves of books, audio books, CDs, and DVDs.



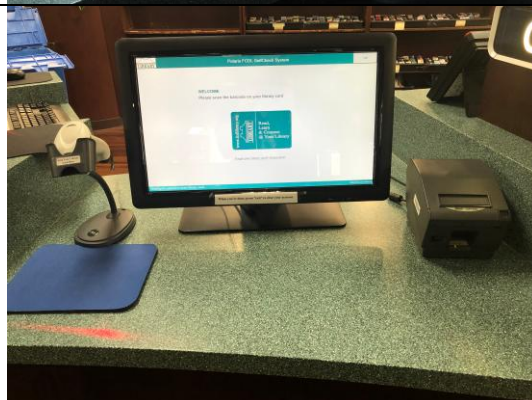
I can sit in a chair to read a book.



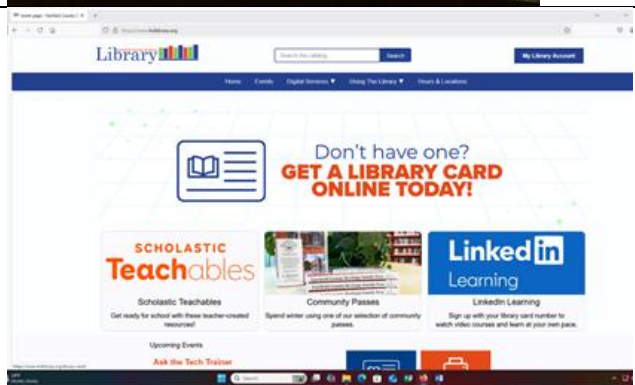
I can borrow a book, audio book, CD, or DVD, and take it home with me.



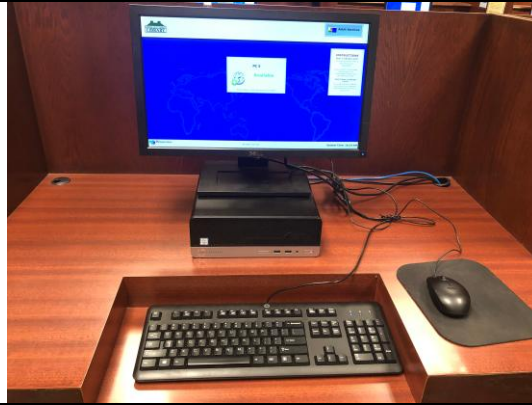
Library staff will show me how to borrow the book, audio book, CD, or DVD, and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library.

The library will also have some computers.



The computers are free to use.



To use the computers, I will need to log on with my library card. The staff will show me how.



When I have finished, I will leave the library.
