Submission Guidelines

Creative Writing Submissions

Work must be:

- An original short story (3,000 words or less), poem (45 lines or less), or non-fiction piece (3,000 words or less), created by the submitting writer
- Based on the theme of Abundance
- Digitally-produced, double-spaced, and submitted by email
- Unpublished (work has not appeared in a book, journal, anthology, textbook, newsletter, newspaper, magazine, or any digital platform i.e. online forums, websites, social media)

In addition:

- The title must appear in the upper right corner of each page submitted
- Page numbers must appear in the bottom right corner
- A cover letter must also be submitted that includes:
 - 1. Author's name
 - 2. Mailing address
 - 3. Phone number
 - 4. Email address
 - 5. Title of submission
 - 6. Word count
 - 7. Entry category (short story, poetry, non-fiction)
- Up to two entries may be submitted per person
- Submitted work should be *publication ready*

Cover Art Submissions

Work must be:

- An original piece, created by submitting artist
- Based on the theme of Abundance
- Presented in an acceptable and tasteful manner
- In JPG, PNG, or GIF format and submitted by email
- 6"x9" in diameter with line work resolution of 600dpi or more, OR 300dpi or more for all other art forms
- Able to translate well from color to black and white

In addition:

- A cover letter must also be submitted that includes:
 - 1. Artist's name
 - 2. Mailing address
 - 3. Phone number
 - 4. Email address
 - 5. Title of submission
 - 6. Medium
 - 7. Description of artwork (25 words or less)
- Up to two entries may be submitted per person
- Submitted work should be *publication ready*

What Next...

Judging

- All entries will be ranked anonymously, based on content, originality, and quality of expression.
- Judges' decisions are final.

If Selected

- Writers and artists of top-ranking submissions will be asked to sign a licensing agreement which gives Henderson Libraries the right to publish and distribute selected work indefinitely.
- Authors and artists will retain copyright of their individual work.

Publication

- Top-ranking manuscripts and cover art submissions will be published in the anthology Impressions: Abundance.
- This anthology provides local authors and artists the opportunity to build name recognition and readership/viewership.
- Cover images will be printed in color. All other selected images will be printed in black and white.
- Copies of the anthology will not be distributed or sold by Henderson Libraries. However, copies will be added to our circulating collection and available for check out.
