Entry Rules Agreement:

- Open to any K-12th grader who is a resident of Jefferson County.
- Students can submit one original work of art produced within the last twelve months.
- Teachers can submit artwork for students, but will be responsible for picking up the artwork. If this is the case, please list teacher's email as contact information.
- Artwork must be exhibition ready, which means it can be immediately displayed. All artwork must less than 50lbs, either be mounted to 3/16" form board (preferred) or framed with hanging wire/picture wire on the back. If mounted on foam board, the library will apply velcro to the back for hanging. Sculpture pieces are considered exhibition ready.
- Artwork should be dropped off in the Children's Department before or by Saturday, September 30th, with an entry form attached to the back of the work.
- Due to limited space, not all artwork will be selected for display.
- Accepted entries will be displayed in Homewood Library's Ellenburg Art Gallery during the month of October.
