Request an Item for Library Purchase



Did you know that we have a form specifically for your requests? We call it an "Orange Card" (because we print it on orange paper), but you can call it anything you want! The important thing is that you know it is available any time you want to request an item that we don't have.

Here are a couple of scenarios where these might be beneficial to you.

There is a new book out, but the Kendallville Public Library doesn't own a copy. Other Evergreen Indiana libraries do, but because it is a new item, there is a 6 month wait before it can leave its home library. Request the book!

You're looking for a DVD, but not only is it not available at the Kendallville Public Library...it can't be found anywhere within the Evergreen Indiana consortium. Request it!

We purchase as many of these requests as possible, but please understand that sometimes an item is out of print or rare, and the cost to purchase it might just be too great to justify the use it will get. But it never hurts to ask!

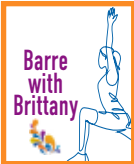
