Celebrating 40 Years of Lynette!

This year, we celebrate a huge milestone—Lynette Barnett’s 40th anniversary with the Kendallville Public Library. Lynette began in 1985 as a shelver in the Children’s Department on Rush Street, later becoming a clerk and then Circulation Manager when the library moved to its current Park Avenue location. She’s been part of major changes, from reissuing every library card during the move to Evergreen Indiana to leading the switch from Dewey Decimal to a topical system—all while encouraging her team with her signature phrase, “You’ll get it!”

Coworkers describe Lynette as a patient teacher, a fair and compassionate leader, and someone who brings joy to her work. Anita shared, “Her professional interactions with the community are seasoned with joy from a happy heart. Lynette’s kind professionalism has been clearly seen and patiently taught to all the staff. Her encouragement makes such a great impact on our Library team.” Lynette is also known for her impeccable style (“pretty in pink”), her wealth of Evergreen knowledge, and her ability to make every day more fun. Whether training new staff, answering tricky questions, or sharing laughs in the workroom, she leads by example and makes the library a better place.



Lynette says her favorite change over the years has been watching the library expand its resources, from Libby to museum passes. But her favorite moment is still the joy on a child’s face when they get their first library card. She calls herself blessed to have worked here for 40 years—but it’s clear the blessing has been ours.



And, in true Lynette fashion, you might notice something a little different this month—the entire newsletter is pretty in pink in her honor. Congratulations, Lynette!

By the Numbers - Your Library in Action!

Our library has been buzzing with activity in 2025! So far this year, patrons have borrowed more than 14,000 eBooks, audiobooks, and magazines through Overdrive, with audiobooks topping the charts. Hoopla has been just as popular, with over 2,800 checkouts of movies, TV shows, music, and books.

We've answered over 1,600 patron questions—including 954 reference questions, 124 tech help requests, and 80 genealogy inquiries. Our Genealogy Room has already welcomed 337 visitors, and study rooms have been used 750 times.

Programs are thriving, too! Between our Kendallville and Limberlost branches, more than 1,400 people have attended library events this year. And book bundles are a hit—16 families have taken home a hand-picked stack of great reads.

From digital downloads to in-person programs, your library is busy, growing, and here to connect you with what you love.

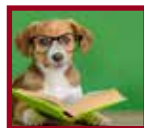
