Did you know the Kendallville Library offers a variety of workout programs for FREE? Adults are welcome to come walk with us and do Yoga, Barre and Pound exercise classes. And we have a Family in Motion class for all ages!

Instructor Dawn O'Bran has been leading Pound for 7 years. She wants everyone to know that it is an exercise for every age at every stage! Pound is a choreographed routine that involves green drumsticks that become your tool to become a part of the music. If you love music and are looking for a new way to engage in movement, you will love Pound!

Yoga and Barre is taught by instructor Brittany Leath. "My classes can be modified for all levels, especially Barre. It's important for people to listen to their bodies and I encourage people to do that throughout class. I encourage all patrons to sign up for something new and find a fun challenge, even if it's not one of the fitness classes." We also offer a Barre and Yoga class each month at our Limberlost Branch.

November wraps up our Fall Walk series. This month, we are walking around Bixler Lake and throughout Gene Stratton Porter. We're excited to continue this next spring.
