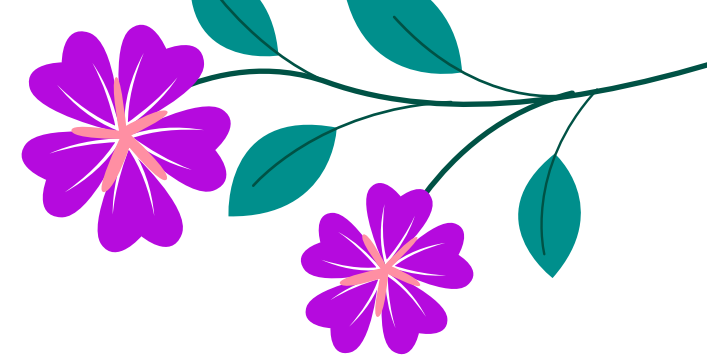


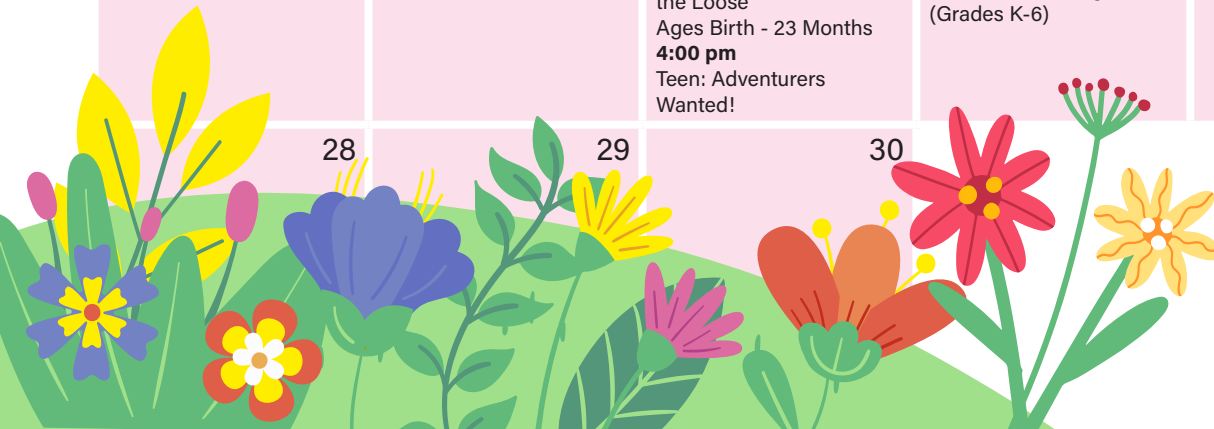

Wednesday, April 10 • 1:30 pm

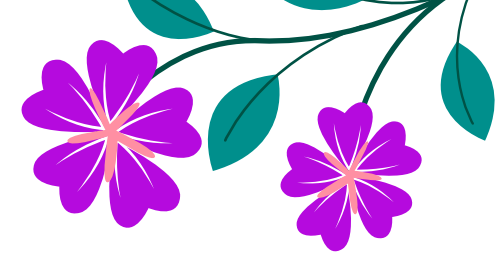
