

# TAKE & MAKE

# FABRIC BOOKMARK

## Kit Contents:

- Fabric
- Cork with adhesive backing 6"x6"

## Other Supplies You Need:

- Sharp Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil/Pen



Indulge your love of reading with a fun bookmark. This bookmark idea also makes cute gifts.

## Instructions:

- If the fabric has creases in it you may want to iron it flat.
- On a flat surface, lay your fabric piece face down.
- Peel the backing off of your cork sheet.
- Press the adhesive side of the cork to the wrong side of your fabric.
  - The fabric is a little bigger than the cork, so you have a little wiggle room to get the cork completely covered.
- Press down on the cork to get good adhesion. Flip the cork over and press on the fabric as well.
- Use a ruler to measure 1-2" from the bottom of the cork, using a pen/pencil to make a small mark. Go to the top of the cork and measure the same distance. Use your marks to draw a straight line, creating a bookmark sized strip.
  - You should be able to draw several lines to create 3-4 bookmarks depending on how thin your bookmarks are.
- Cut on the line to create a bookmark. You will need good sharp scissors.
  - *Want a different look?*
    - Bring your prepped cork (fabric on cork & lines drawn on the cork) to the library and borrow our pinking shears to cut the edges of your bookmark.
      - *The pinking shears will be available at the library through Oct 24.*
