Agatha Christie was a mystery writer who was one of the world's top-selling authors with works like 'Murder on the Orient Express' and 'The Mystery of the Blue Train.' Best-selling author Agatha Christie published her first novel, The Mysterious Affair at Styles, in 1920, and went on to become one of the most famous writers in history, with mysteries like Murder at the Vicarage, Partners in Crime and Sad Cypress. She sold billions of copies of her work and was also a noted playwright and romance author.

- 8. Discuss the plot:
 - a. Is the story interesting?
 - b. Is the story plot driven?
 - c. Is the book a "page turner" or does it unfold slowly?
- 9. Discuss the book's structure:
 - a. Does the time line move forward chronologically?
 - b. Is it a continuous story or is it interlocking short stories?
 - c. Is there a single viewpoint or shifting viewpoints?
 - d. Why did the author tell the story this way?
- 10. What main ideas or themes does the author explore?
- 11. If you were to guess at a formative experience in the author's life based on this book, what would you guess?
- 12. If you were to sum up this book in one tweet, what would you say in 140 characters?

13. Is the ending satisfying? Has the book changed you? Have you learned something?
