

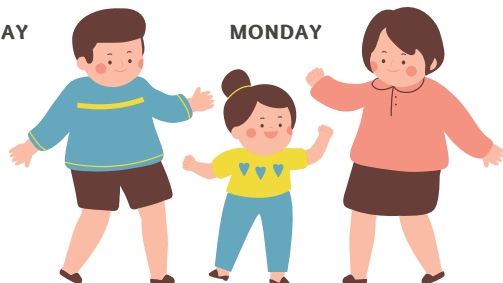

Write and mail a letter to a friend or family member you haven't seen in a while.

2
It's Groundhog Day! Did the groundhog see his shadow? What does that mean?

3
Today is "Take Your Child to the Library Day"! Stop by your local library for a look around.

4
Look at the calendar together and count the days until Valentine's Day. Draw a heart around February 14th.

5
Read a book with the word "great" in the title.

6
Ask your child questions that have more than a yes or no answer. "What is something fun we did today?"

7
Start a new audiobook in the Libby, Hoopla, or Tumblebooks app!

8
Pretend you are going on a trip. What will you bring? How will you travel?

9
Put lines and shapes on the floor with masking tape, then walk along them like a pretend balance beam.

10
Look through family photos and write funny captions for them.

11
Talk about the safety rules your child knows for staying safe online for Safer Internet Day.

12
When reading together, stop and ask your child how a character is feeling. When have you felt that way?

13
For World Radio Day, listen to your favorite radio station together! Talk about what you hear.

14
Make a special card for a loved one for Valentine's Day.

15
Write a message in the snow using your footprints.

16
Together, make a list of things to do today. Check off each thing as it's completed.

17
It's Family Day! Choose a family activity to do together.

18
Make a chart of family preferences. List family member names and their favorite colours, fruits, animals, etc.

19
Get a good night's sleep with a bedtime story.

20
Learn a new word to describe how you feel, like "I feel ecstatic" rather than "I feel happy."

21
After reading together, talk about interesting words from the book.

22
Build physical literacy by doing some exercises together.

23
Look in the mirror and make self-portraits together. It doesn't have to be perfect, just have fun!

24
Learn how to sing "O Canada" in Sign Language!

25
Eat fruits and vegetables today. Talk about the plant parts you are eating. "Leaf, fruit, stem, root..."

26
Today is Pink Shirt Day. Talk with your child about what bullying is, and what they can do to stop it.

27
Look up a fun fact about the last animal you saw.

28
Celebrate the shortest month by reading the shortest book you can find!

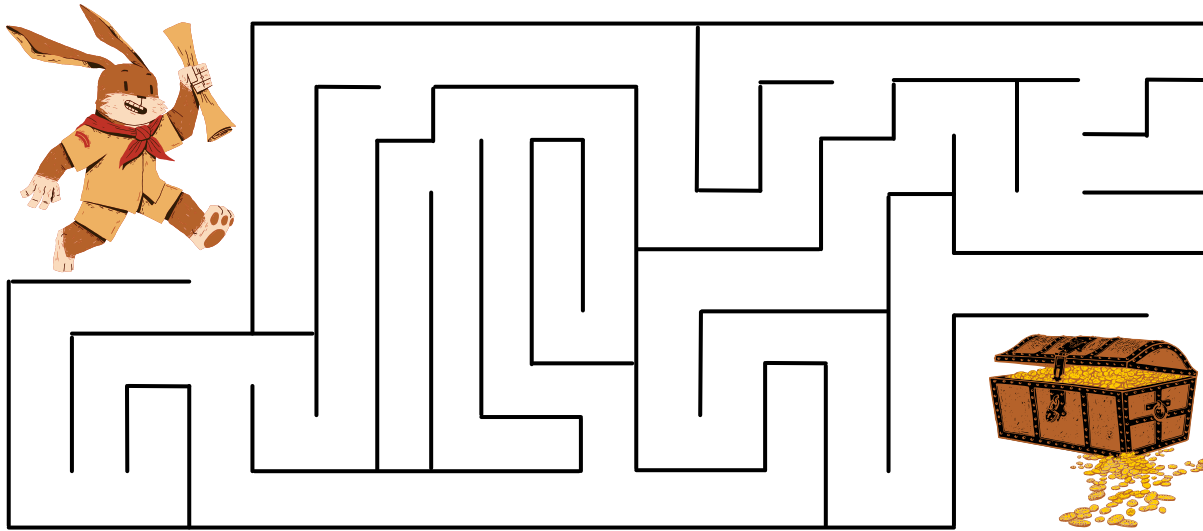


Library Visits
