We can offer a variety of tours for your classroom. Tours could include a program if desired as well as library card registrations for students.



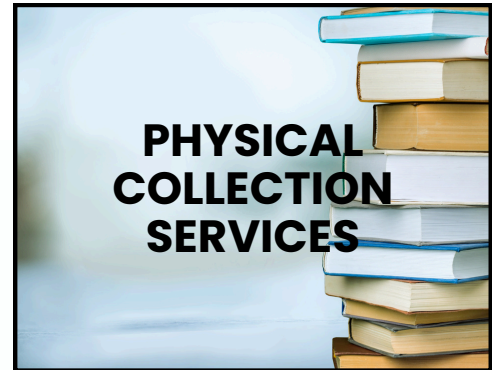
School Visits




