This is the reception desk at the library. Someone will say hello to me when I come in.



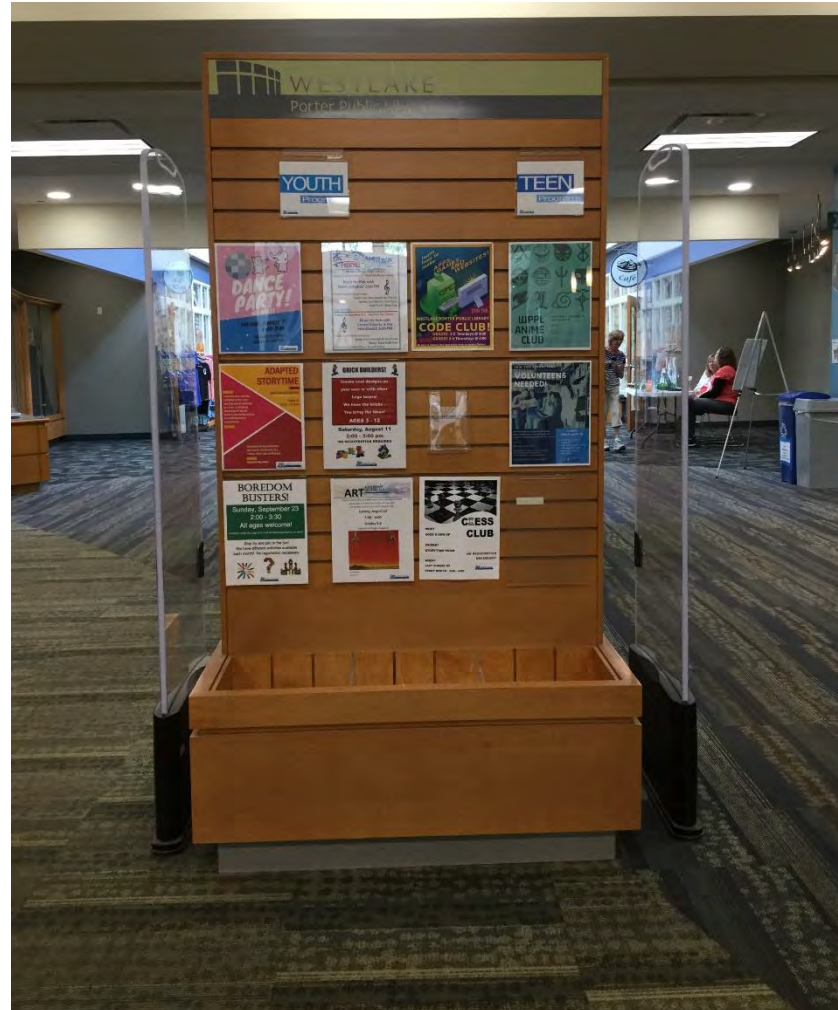
This is where I can return anything I borrowed from the library.
