PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



2023 was a big year for the Friends of Porter Public Library: we started the year by celebrating our 50th birthday with a birthday party; donated \$100,000 for the Outdoor Pavilion; sponsored a brick walkway leading to the outdoor pavilion; held a fundraiser at Houlihan's; closed our gift shop Portables; moved our used book store, the Book Nook, to a larger more visible location in the old gift shop; had a very successful October big book sale; added book art to items for sale in the bookstore, and ended the year helping the Youth Services department put on a fantastic Christmas party for young children.

But we aren't resting on our laurels. Our volunteers are already sorting through donations and library withdrawals getting ready for our October 2024 big book sale. We have, thanks to volunteer help, been able to expand our Book Nook hours to one more afternoon. The Book Nook is now open 4 days a week: Monday from 3-7; Wednesday from 10--2; Thursday from 1-5 and Saturday from 10-2. Stop by and see our fantastic selections. You won't find better prices anywhere. We are also continuing to add to the outdoor brick walkway. See the enclosed order sheet. Order your outdoor pavilion brick now to be included in the Spring 2024 installation! Great gift idea for Mother's Day, Father's Day, graduations, weddings, and anniversaries. These hours included the help of the men of Community Service Alliance, and 14 students from Westlake High School Honor Society, who donated their help on Saturday and Sunday. We would also like to thank the staff of the library who made sure the sale was possible. A big Thank You to all of them for their help and support. We were able to raise about \$13,000, which the Friends of Porter Public Library will use to fund various programs at the library throughout the year.

The staff at the library has already scheduled the next Big Sale for October of 2024, so put that on your calendar. Until then, we hope you will visit our new Book Nook sales room. The store is located in the lobby, near the front entrance to the library. We are open Wednesdays and Saturdays from 10-2, Thursdays from 1-5, and Mondays from 3-7, so stop in and see our treasures. We have fiction, non-fiction, children's items, DVDs, Blu Rays, CDs, albums, puzzles, Book Art, and games. As always, we are pleased to accept your donations at the Book Nook workroom at our original location in the hall to the right of the reception desk. Donations can be dropped off at any time.


