Reporting to the Facilities Manager, the Custodian performs a variety of tasks to keep the library buildings, vehicles, garage and grounds in clean, safe and orderly condition.

Key Responsibilities:

- Sweep, mop and scrub, vacuum and dust office space, shelves, computers, stairs and restrooms
- Empty trash and garbage containers
- Move furniture and equipment; set up displays; set up and take down for meeting room programs
- Clean snow and debris from sidewalk and grounds
- Operate library delivery vehicles
- Operate a variety of equipment to clean carpets, floors and furniture

Minimum Qualifications:

- One-year custodial experience
- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Ability to work evenings and weekends
- Valid driver's license and good driving record
- Ability to lift 80 pounds and transport or move up to 100 pounds from one location to another
