

High School Night Laser Tag Rules of Conduct

Inappropriate conduct at High School Night includes but is not limited to the following:

- Abuse, harassment, or bullying of any person
- Misuse, damage, or theft of Library property
- Inappropriate physical contact with another person
- Unsafe physical activity, including climbing, diving, sliding, acrobatics, and throwing objects
- Failure to heed instructions from supervising staff
- Violating any [Library Policy](#)

Special rules for laser tag include but are not limited to the following:

- If you are hurt or need help, tell a supervising adult immediately.
- You may use furniture as cover, but do not move or climb on the furniture.
- Use clean language. Do not use violent language against others, even in play or jest.
- Do not enter any space marked with a “do not enter” sign.
- Do not touch books, technology, toys, displays, or staff equipment while playing unless required for the scavenger hunt.
- Do not touch others while playing, with your body, your laser tag equipment, or any other object.
- Do not block the sensor on your tagger or remove equipment while still playing.
- Abstain from any activity that disrupts others’ enjoyment of the game.
- Do not exit the Kids’ Landing area with laser tag equipment. If you need to exit, you may do so at any time by turning in your equipment to a staff member and leaving the Kids’ Landing area.
- Be a good sport. Respect others, the space, the equipment, and the rules of the game.

The event’s supervising adults reserve the right to determine who has broken a rule and when. If you break a rule, you may be given a warning, asked to exit the game, or your parent/guardian may be called to pick you up.

The Library will notify me if my child is on the waiting list for laser tag. When not playing laser tag, my child may participate in other activities at the event.
