

Displays and Exhibits

The Alexandria Library (the Library) creates displays and exhibits that inform the community and highlight library collections. The primary purpose of exhibits is to extend the Library's role as a cultural, educational and community-centered organization. Display space varies at each location and display themes change year-to-year based on reading interests, current events and other trends.

Due to limited space, display space is reserved for those exhibits sponsored by the Library and created by library staff. At times, the Library will partner with organizations to host professionally designed exhibits of an educational nature. Approval for such exhibits must be arranged through Library Administration.
