



Roku Lending Policy

Purpose: Roku streaming devices are available to Highland Park Public Library cardholders (ages 14 and older) so that they may stream popular TV shows and movies.

Limitations: Wi-Fi connection and a HDTV with a HDMI port are required to use a Roku streaming device. Each Roku is preloaded with selected accounts and content, in accordance with Library collection policies.

Use: The following rules and regulations apply:

1. Roku streaming devices may be borrowed by Highland Park Public Library cardholders ages 14 and older in good standing.
2. The loan period is 7 days with 1 renewal.
3. Roku players must be returned directly to a staff person at the Film & Music desk. They must not be returned in the book drop or to another library.
4. Borrowers may not download or delete any titles, accounts, or content from the Roku player.
5. The library is not responsible for damage to the borrower's personal devices or equipment.
6. The borrower is responsible for returning all Roku parts in good condition. Failure to return an item will result in the following costs charged to the account:
 - a. Roku Streaming Stick + - \$60
 - b. Power adapter & extender cable - \$14
 - c. Remote - \$15
 - d. USB Power Cable with Advanced Wireless Receiver - \$20
 - e. Case - \$6
