



PLAYING OUR WAY TO LITERACY

Read Write Talk Sing Play

MONDAY

Write out letters A-Z. Place the letters on objects that start with that letter. Have your child retrieve the notes and say the name of the object it is on.

TUESDAY

Trace out the first letter of your child's first name. Ask them if they know any other words that start with that letter.

WEDNESDAY

Sing the wheels on the bus. Try the song out for different things like a car, a house or a child's body. Use new words to describe sounds and actions.

THURSDAY

Pick your child's favorite story and act out the story with them.

FRIDAY

Using crayons or markers, have a drawing session on the day's weather. Talk about different weather and what it looks like.

SATURDAY

Ask your child about a place they would like to visit. Keep asking them questions to keep the conversation going.

SUNDAY

When reading to your child ask them what they think comes next. This builds their understanding of sequencing.

LITERACY TIP:

Play with your child a little bit every day. Children learn through play and the more you interact and talk to them, the more they learn about the world.
