Read Write Talk Sing Play

MONDAY

Draw straight, zigzag, and curvy lines on a piece of paper. Have your child practice using safety scissors by cutting them out.

TUESDAY

Play I Spy with colors and objects in your house or outside. Talk about the items as you go.

WEDNESDAY

Play animal charades using animal sounds and actions to guess what they are.

THURSDAY

Use a well known song or lullaby to quiet down before bed. Some of our favorites are Twinkle Twinkle Little Star and Baa Baa Black Sheep.

FRIDAY

Ask your child what they want to be when they grow up. Play pretend with them and act out the job together.

SATURDAY

Read a book with your child in bed today.

SUNDAY

Write down six exercises and number them 1-6. Take turns rolling a die and then do that exercise together.
