

Wi-Fi Internet Access Connection Procedure

Mac iPad

The library has provided wireless network service to connect your personal iPad to the World Wide Web while at your public library. All you need is an iPad with wireless adapter (Wi-Fi) and web browser. **(NOTE: Your web browser must have cookies enabled to access the internet. Network settings must be set to automatic and proxies must be disabled.)**

The following section describes how to connect to a wireless network using the **Settings App** on the Mac iPad. This document presumes that you have the appropriate permissions on your iPad to setup a wireless connection. NOTE: Mac iPad may have additional security features that may periodically ask you if you want to continue making changes during the wireless setup process.

1. Tap on the **Settings** app. The Settings icon looks similar to the following:

2. Once in the settings application, you will be at the General Settings screen. Tap on the **Wi-Fi** category to get to the screen where you will connect to a wireless network as shown below.



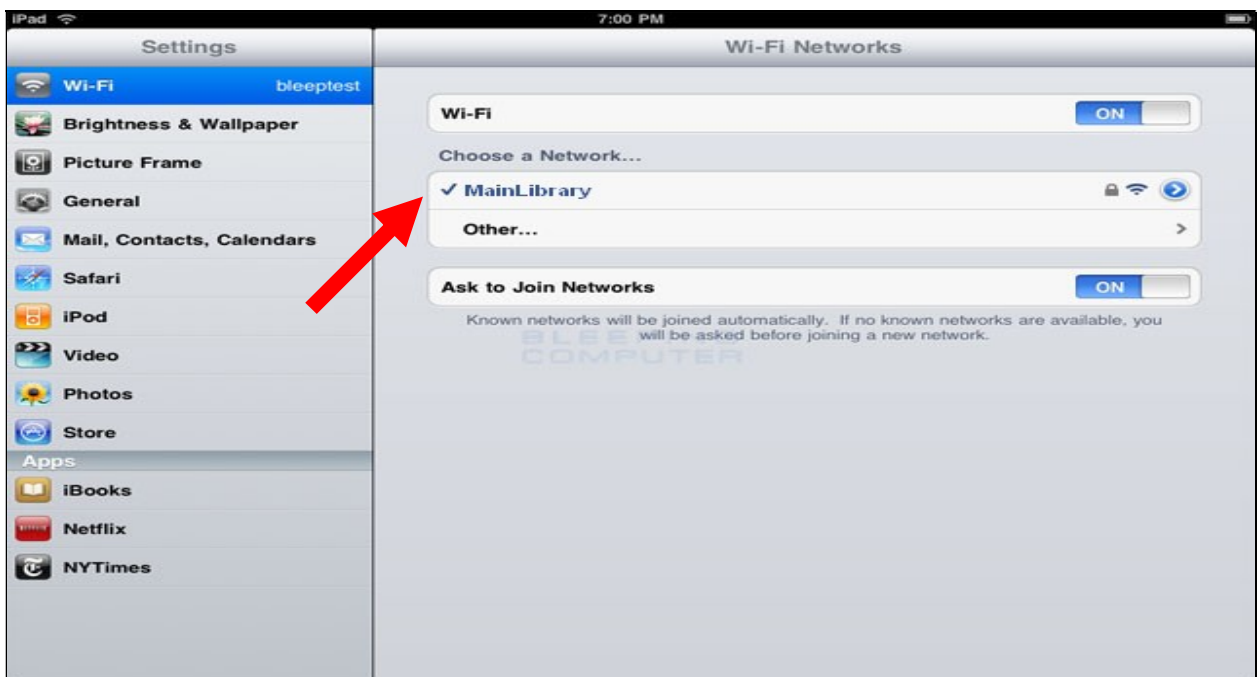
General Settings screen

3. A list of wireless networks will be displayed under the “Choose a Network...” field. These are all the networks that are within range of your iPad. Find the network that displays the **Library’s Name** and tap on it. (Ex.”MainLibrary”)

4. The iPad will now attempt to connect to the network, and when finished, will display the Wi-Fi settings screen again, but this time with the joined network listed with a checkmark next to it as shown below.
